- Asked national government to transfer national government agencies to Kansai
 - The Agency for Cultural Affairs established the Headquarters for Vitalizing Regional Cultures in preparation for the full-scale relocation of the Agency to the Kansai region and the implementation of office work and projects in advance to meet new policy needs while making use of knowledge and know-how locally available. (April 2017)
 - The Consumer Affairs Agency opened the Consumer Administration New Future Creation Office as a base for the development and creation of a new consumer administration for the future. (July 2017)
 - The Statistics Bureau under the Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications established the Statistical Data Utilization Center as a base for promoting advanced data utilization. (April 2018)
- Established the "Sports Promotion" section in the Region-wide Tourism, Culture, and Sports Promotion Office. (September 2015)
- Developed the "Kansai Region-wide Sports Promotion Vision" (March 2016)
- Established the Kansai International Tourism Promotion Headquarters (March 2016) (Integrated with the Foundation for Kansai Region Promotion in April 2017 and the KANSAI Tourism Bureau was launched.)
- Formulated the Strategy for Revitalizing Kansai 2016 - 2019 (April 2016 (revised August 2018))
- Dealt with the Kumamoto earthquake and Central Tottori earthquake (April, October 2016)
- Launched a forum to exchange opinions with younger members of the UKG Council (Held in Tokushima Prefecture in August 2016, Tottori Prefecture in September 2017, and Shiga Prefecture in December 2018.)
- Passed a resolution to work towards a successful bid to hold the EXPO 2025 Osaka, Kansai, Japan at the UKG Commission (September 2016)
 - The 2025 Japan World Exposition Promotion Committee, which consists of local governments and economic organizations, including Osaka Prefecture, Osaka City, and the UKG, has been launched to promote the invitation of the EXPO. (March 2017)
 - The decision was made to hold the EXPO 2025 Osaka, Kansai, Japan. (November 2018)
